## Nominations are open for MU Staff Advisory Council Members

The MU Staff Advisory Council is seeking nominations for its upcoming summer elections. Nominees must be full-time MU Campus or Extension staff (*not UM System*) (75% and above) who have completed one year of service prior to nomination. Six members will be elected to serve three-year terms beginning September 1, 2008.

Formed in 1978, the Council advises the Chancellor on matters of concern to staff at MU. Council members are an important link between employees and the administration, providing and receiving information. The meetings of the SAC are generally held on the second and fourth Thursdays of each month.

The Council is comprised of 16 members, four from each of the following job classifications: administrative/professional, crafts/maintenance, secretarial/clerical, and technical/para-professional.
