Any high school graduate, if not currently enrolled in the University of Missouri-Columbia, is eligible to participate in the program. *Students on dismissal status from MU or any other institution are not eligible to participate in this program until one year has elapsed since their dismissal.*

**EASY ACCESS  
130 JESSE HALL  
UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI-COLUMBIA**

The Easy Access Program is designed for those who wish to study part-time and those not interested in actively pursuing a degree. Students may register for a maximum of six hours in regular terms, and three hours in summer. Graduate credit is not allowed through Easy Access, and permission must be obtained from either the professor or the department prior to enrolling in courses requiring consent. Students wishing to participate in MU's Evening Program need to contact MU Direct, (573) 882-3598 or 1-800-545-2604 or [www.MUDirect.missouri.edu](http://www.MUDirect.missouri.edu).

Bring completed Easy Access Application to 130 Jesse Hall during Easy Access Registration. (See Schedule of Courses or call (573) 882-7881.)

The following policies govern the registrant in Easy Access:

- 1) Students on academic dismissal status from any institution, including the University of Missouri-Columbia, are not eligible to register until one year has elapsed.
- 2) Students expelled from the University System may not enroll through Easy Access.
- 3) Students may not transfer into a degree granting division of the University during the term in which they are enrolled in Easy Access.
- 4) Transfer into a degree granting division of the University requires completion of the regular application process.
- 5) Registration is open on a space available basis. Space will not be available in graduate courses, Law, Medicine, Veterinary Medicine, Journalism or most Nursing courses. Normally no space is available in Accountancy, Computer Science and some courses in other departments.
- 6) Students enrolling in Easy Access will not normally be eligible for financial aid, since the program is non-degree in orientation.
- 7) The Office of the University Registrar serves as "Dean's Office" for Easy Access students. "Adding and Dropping" of courses begins in 130 Jesse Hall. Academic advising is generally not available, the Registration staff in the Office of the University Registrar will give whatever assistance it can in arranging courses.
- 8) No graduate credit is available through Easy Access.
- 9) Fees for students enrolling through Easy Access are the same as for those regularly admitted students. Fees are payable the day of registration.
- 10) International students will be required to provide proof of a TOEFL of 500 or better.
- 11) Students must be high school graduates.
- 12) See Schedule of Courses, available on-line, [http://registrar.missouri.edu/Schedule\\_of\\_Courses/index.htm](http://registrar.missouri.edu/Schedule_of_Courses/index.htm) for dates of registration, refund dates, directory information, and academic policies.
- 13) Students are subject to appropriate University policies, including dismissal and probationary enrollment.
- 14) Residency Statement - It is your duty to apply and register under the proper residence and to pay the proper fees. A pamphlet giving detailed information on tuition and residence rules may be obtained from the Residency Office, 230 Jesse Hall.
